

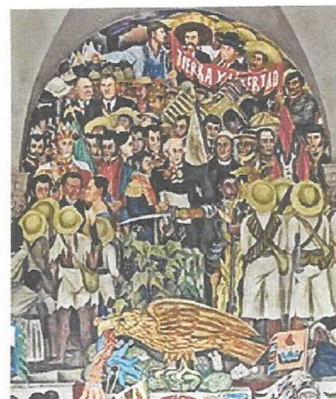

Mexican Muralism: Public Art, Identity and Collective Memory with Maria Chester

Mexico has a long tradition of mural painting, from the Mayans to the Colonial era, often full of political and social meaning. The 'Mexican Muralism' movement began in the 1920's funded by the post-revolution government to build a sense of national identity. Depicting the history of the past, present and future, the murals were painted directly onto the walls of public buildings, communicating this idealism to all, rich as well as illiterate poor. 'The Big Three' best known artists are, David Alfaro Siqueiros, Jose Clemente Orozco and Diego Rivera. Initially influenced by western avant-garde art, they soon developed their own styles.
